

Extracted from the Principal Registry of Her Majesty's Court of Probate

On the 23rd day of March 1867 Letters of Administration of all and singular the personal estate and effects of Richard Oliver late of Westoning in the County of Bedford Farmer deceased who died on the 25th day of June 1853 at Westoning aforesaid a Bachelor without Father or Mother and Intestate left unadministered by James Oliver deceased whilst living the natural and lawful Brother and one of the next of kin of the said deceased were granted at the Principal Registry of Her Majesty's Court of Probate to Thomas Oliver of Hatfield in the County of Hertford Farmer the lawful and natural Brother also and one of the other of the next of kin of the said deceased he having been first sworn duly to Administer Effects under Two hundred pounds – Former Grant Archdeaconry Court of Bedford – October 1853
