... Another name worthy of mention is that of William Hale, who died in October 1828, at the age of 57 years. The inscription on his tomb reveals the esteem with which he was held. It states that he "after many years of affliction, is now gone to enjoy the presence of that dear Saviour he so often spoke of to us, His family, as the true and faithful friend to all that seek Him in real truth, and uprightness of heart."

N.B. WB Gerish records Williams date of death as 11/10/1828.
