

Will / Probate of Mary Palmer

In the name of God Amen I Mary Palmer relict of Will^m Palmer and now residing at Wellwyn in the county of Hertd being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be the almighty God for the same do hereby make and publicise this as my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first I give and bequeath unto each of my sisters Sarah Eutirt Nap and Elizabeth Millidge the sum of Ten Pounds each of lawful money of Great Britain I also give and bequeath unto each of my sister Elizabeth's children viz Sarah Temple(?) Mary P(?) William Millidge Elizabeth Millidge and Thomas Millidge the sum of Five Pounds each of lawful money of Great Britain and lastly to all the rest residue and remainder of my personal estate goods and chattels of what kind or nature whatsoever linen(?) jewels(?) and apparel I give and bequeath the same to Mrs Jane Troup of the parish of Wellwyn whom I hereby appoint to be sole executrix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made In witness whereof(?) I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th day of February in the year of our Lord 1808 and in the 48th year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George King of Great Britain & Ireland Signed sealed published and declared by the above named Mary Palmer to be the last will and testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the Testator Mary Palmer Edw^d Batten Thomas Catlin Robert Wood
